LATEST NEWS FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF QUEENSLAND

LEARNING

- L1 UQ has pushed into the world's top 50 in both the 2018 <u>Performance Ranking of Scientific</u> <u>Papers for World Universities</u> and the <u>US News Best Global Universities</u>, placing <u>41st</u> and <u>45th</u> respectively.
- L2 The UQ Business School's MBA program has <u>ranked</u> first in Australia and the Asia-Pacific and 16th in the world in the <u>2017 Economist MBA rankings</u>.
- L3 UQ has <u>announced</u> the results of elections and Governor-in-Council appointments to its 34th Senate.
- L4 Professor Julie Cogin has been <u>appointed</u> to the role of Academic Dean and Head of the UQ Business School. She will take up the role in January 2018.
- L5 UQ's <u>Professor Gita Mishra</u> and <u>Professor Sunil Lakhani</u> have been <u>elected</u> as Fellows of the <u>Australian Academy of Health and Medical Sciences</u>.
- L6 UQ kidney and chronic disease researcher <u>Professor Wendy Hoy</u> has been <u>elected</u> to the Council of the <u>Australian Academy of Science</u>.
- **L7** UQ PhD student Mellissa Houghton's study into a sub-Antarctic island's ecosystem has <u>won</u> her a prestigious <u>Australian Academy of Science</u> award.
- L8 Three of the top five spots in a prestigious national economics essay competition have been <u>claimed</u> by UQ students.
- **L9** Three UQ teachers have been <u>recognised</u> for their dedication and contributions to student learning at the <u>Australian Awards for University Teaching</u>.
- **L10** Alumni from around the world were <u>celebrated</u> at the 2017 UQ Alumni Awards. Awardees included humanitarians, business leaders, researchers and a journalist.
- **L11** The cream of UQ's teaching crop has been <u>fêted</u> at the annual UQ Awards for Excellence in Teaching and Learning.
- L12 UQ economics student Thu Hoang was recently <u>named</u> a regional winner for Oceania in the 2017 <u>Undergraduate Awards</u>.

DISCOVERY

- **D1** The <u>Australian Research Council</u> has <u>awarded</u> UQ researchers \$32 million for work designed to create positive change across science, health, engineering and the humanities.
- **D2** Efforts to rid the world of polio have <u>taken</u> another significant step, thanks to research led by UQ bioscience experts and funding from the <u>World Health Organisation</u>.

- **D3** Six UQ projects will <u>tackle</u> the challenges of a modern Australia, thanks to \$4.2 million in Queensland Government funding.
- **D4** A UQ-led maternity program designed to achieve better health outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women and their babies has <u>received</u> a \$1.1 million grant from the National Health and Medical Research Council.
- **D5** UQ researchers have been <u>awarded</u> almost \$1 million to develop a new antibiotic that could treat life-threatening bacterial infections resistant to all known antibiotics.
- **D6** Research into brain development and schizophrenia has led to <u>international acclaim</u> for UQ's <u>Professor John McGrath</u>, recipient of Denmark's Strömgren Medal.
- **D7** UQ research projects to develop better batteries for renewable energy and a way of predicting crop yields from space have been <u>funded</u> under a joint Queensland-China scheme.
- **D8** UQ scientist <u>Professor Jian Yang</u>, whose pioneering work has helped unravel the complexity of the human genome and genetic traits, has <u>won</u> the 2017 Prime Minister's Prize for Science.
- **D9** UQ's <u>Dr Jacqui Romero</u> has <u>won</u> a <u>L'Oréal-UNESCO For Women in Science</u> award for her work on quantum alphabets.
- **D10** Global health care leader MSD has <u>signed</u> an agreement with UQ to develop a platform for new immuno-oncology therapies.
- **D11** An international team of mental health experts, including two UQ researchers, has <u>developed</u> a framework to help children recover from trauma, with the support of The Prince of Wales.
- **D12** A global study, including UQ researcher <u>Professor Peter Sly</u>, has <u>found</u> diseases caused by pollution were responsible for an estimated nine million premature deaths in 2015.
- **D13** Babies born even a few weeks early are more likely to have poor physical fitness throughout life, UQ researchers have <u>found</u>.
- **D14** A UQ-led study has <u>found</u> fanged kangaroos an extinct family of small fanged Australian kangaroos might have survived at least five million years longer than previously thought.
- **D15** Women who consume alcohol around the time of conception could be putting their male offspring at greater risk of obesity in later life, UQ researchers have <u>found</u>.
- **D16** A prehistoric Ice Age marsupial related to wombats and koalas has been <u>discovered</u> by UQ's Dr Gilbert Price to be the only marsupial known to have followed annual seasonal migration.
- **D17** UQ engineering student James Cooney <u>collaborated</u> with <u>Cancer Council Queensland</u> to harness technology in the battle against Queensland's soaring rates of skin cancer.
- **D18** A discovery by UQ researchers that bees have individual flying direction preferences could <u>lead</u> to strategies for steering drone aircraft fleets.
- **D19** A UQ-led study has <u>found</u> the built environment has a powerful impact on the health of older people and on their ability to age well.

- E1 UQ has <u>launched</u> the \$500 million philanthropic campaign <u>Not If, When the Campaign to</u> <u>Create Change</u>.
- **E2** UQ has been <u>invited</u> to take a leadership role in the design and management of the new \$27.125 million <u>Strategic Resources Exploration Program</u>.
- **E3** The new \$10 million Australian Research Council Training Centre for Biopharmaceutical Innovation, led by UQ's Australian Institute for Bioengineering and Nanotechnology, has <u>launched</u>.
- **E4** In partnership with the Queensland Government, UQ has been <u>enlisted</u> by the <u>HYPE</u> <u>Foundation</u> to champion sports entrepreneurship and sportstech innovation.
- **E5** UQ's <u>Professor André Drenth</u> will be one of the first scientists to <u>participate</u> in a new Indonesian Government program that aims to strengthen Indonesia's global research collaborations and boost food security.
- **E6** UQ has <u>welcomed</u> the President of the Republic of Kiribati and UQ alumnus, His Excellency Taneti Maamau, to its St Lucia campus.
- **E7** UQ <u>produced</u> enough solar energy to power 1592 homes in 2016 and has decreased its power consumption by 10 per cent since 2013.

- E12 UQ's Moreton Bay Research Station opened its doors to the public for its annual open day.
- **E13** UQ Sports Achievement Scholarship recipient Gabi Simpson was <u>selected</u> in the Australian Diamonds' 2018 Quad Series squad.
- **E14** Fourteen UQ Ideas Hub students have <u>embarked</u> on a four-week international internship in the heart of global start-up movement, Tel Aviv, Israel.
